*With the WUE program, students who meet the university's admission criteria and live in one of 14 Western states can receive a tuition rate that is about 40% less than NAU's non-resident rate. Louie/Jacks Transfer Award	Up to \$2,000 (statewide locations) or up to \$4,000 (Flagstaff campus), renewable for one additional year.	Transfer students who meet certain need-based criteria, as determined by the FAFSA. Must be enrolled at NAU full time (12+ credits per semester).
 2NAU Scholarship	\$2,000, renewable for one additional year.	Students who have completed at least two terms in the 2NAU program, 45 or more transferable credit hours, and a 3.0 cumulative transfer GPA. Must be enrolled full time (12+ credits per semester) to receive this award.
Phi Theta Kappa*	\$4,000 (Arizona Residents) and \$6,000 (non-residents including WUE).	Members of the Phi Theta Kappa international honor society of two-year colleges who hold a 3.5+ cumulative transfer GPA and enroll full time (12+ credits) at NAU.

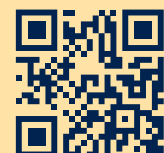
